

Create Inset Lines

Make a New File

Make a selection with the rectangular Marquee tool.
Fill the selection with the "Brushed Metal Texture".



Set your foreground color to black.

Use the pencil tool. Set the width to about 3 pixels (your choice on thickness) and draw the lines you want to be inset. (Tip: Hold the Shift key to draw straight lines).



BE SURE THE LINES ARE ON A SEPARATE LAYER.

Go to Layer/Layer Styles and choose Bevel and Emboss.
Choose Pillow Emboss and set the parameters to your desired level of emboss.

To make the screws:

Make the foreground and background colors black and white.
Press D on the keyboard.

Make an elliptical selection, fill with black and white gradient.

Make a new layer.

Draw a line through the center of the shape.

Use the same pillow emboss technique to create the "screw".



Make the bumps.

Use the gradient tool to create other shapes on the metal texture.
